All of them have been examined.</li> <li>• 01 representation (Roll No.28) is against rejection under Lacking Enhance Criteria (LEC). The representation alongwith Online Recruitment Application has been examined and it is observed that his claim in the online application don't establish his eligibility and hence, his rejection under Lacking Enhance Criteria (LEC) is maintained.</li> <li>• 07 representations (Roll No.50, 76, 110, 119, 138, 165 &amp;169) are against rejection under "Not fulfilling shortlisting Criteria". The representations alongwith Online Recruitment Applications have been examined and it is observed that their claims in the online applications do not establish their eligibility and hence, their rejections under "Not fulfilling shortlisting Criteria" are maintained.</li> <li>• 02 representations (Roll No.116 &amp; 144) are against rejection under "Incomplete Application" Criteria. The representations alongwith Online Recruitment Applications have been examined and it is observed that their claims in the online applications do not establish their eligibility and hence, their rejections under "Incomplete Application" Criteria are maintained.</li> <li>• 01 representation (Roll No.171) is against rejection under "Overage" Criteria. The representation alongwith Online Recruitment Application has been examined and it is observed that his claim in the online application don't establish his eligibility and hence, his rejection under "Overage" Criteria is maintained.</li> <li>• Accordingly no revision of scrutiny is necessary and it remains unchanged as under:-</li> </ul>

However, wherever the applicants have not submitted experience certificates in prescribed proforma, their</p>	

	<p>experience certificates have been considered on merit.</p> <p>(iv) Experience Certificate issued by Bar Association/Hon'ble Judicial Magistrate has been considered towards EQ-B.</p> <p>(v) Duration of claimed experience of practicing in a court of law in ORA as well as period of pursuing LLM degree, has been considered towards 'experience', in case both the activities i.e. period of claimed experience of practicing in a court of law and concerned college/university of LLM are in same station.</p> <p>(vi) Five Years Course of Bachelor of Laws/Five Years Integrated Course of BA, LLB/Bachelor of Arts Bachelor of Law etc. has been considered towards requirement of EQ-A.</p> <p>(vii) For variation in spelling of names/change in name, Affidavit may be considered sufficient.</p> <p>(viii) In view of the undertaking signed by the candidates in the application, the undertaking regarding intimation to employer wherever applicable, may not be insisted upon specifically.</p> <p>(ix) Some of the candidates can be rejected under more than one category. They have been rejected under the category considered as most appropriate.</p>
