ESSENTIAL QUALIFICATIONS:

(A) EDUCATIONAL:

- (i) MBBS Degree
- (ii) Post-Graduate degree in the concerned speciality or super speciality from a recognised institute.

(B) EXPERIENCE: At least three years' teaching experience as Senior Resident or Tutor or Demonstrator or Registrar or Assistant Professor or Lecturer in the concerned Specialty or Super Specialty in a recognized teaching institution after obtaining the first Post Graduate degree.

The total numbers of effective applications is 65. All the applications have been considered.

- 1.** The scrutiny and short-listing details of this recruitment case were initially uploaded on the website of the Commission on 04/03/2022.
- 2.** The candidates were given a window to express their concerns through email by 20.03.2022.
- 3.** A total of 05 representations have been received so far and all of them have been examined.

4. Two candidates (Roll No. 11 & 45) have represented against their rejection under LEQ-B category. Their representations along with their application dossiers have been examined and it is observed that:

- After re-examining the application dossiers of both the candidates , it is found that both the candidates don't have three years' valid teaching experience , hence their rejection under LEQ-B is maintained.

5. Two candidates (Roll No. 23 & 64) have represented against their rejection under LEQ-A category. Their representations along with their application dossiers have been examined and it is observed that:

- Roll no. 64 was asked through Email on 12.10.2021 & 10.12.2021 to submit DNB equivalence certificate , but he did not send the same within the stipulated time period. Hence, his rejection is maintained.
- Roll no. 23 did not claim PG degree while fulfilling the online application. Hence, his rejection is maintained.

6. One candidate (Roll Nos. 62) has represented against his rejection under Incomplete Category due to "No response to Email for submitting deficient documents". His representation was examined and it has been found that the applicant was emailed on 12.10.2021 asking him to submit deficient documents and he has not sent the deficient document he was asked for, hence his rejection is maintained.
